Juniors 5th and 6th Grade Competition Rules

1. Number of players per side

4 aside. No goalkeepers. Rolling Subs.

2. Duration of matches:

5th-6th Grade 2 x 15 min halves plus half time. **Start times for this grade is 10.00am. It is recommended that these teams coaching should be on a Sunday morning one half hour before their games start times.**

3. Free/penalty/Goal Kicks.

All free kicks are to be indirect. A goal can not therefore be scored directly from a free kick, unless it is touched by a player (of either team) other than the kicker before it goes through the goal posts.

At free kicks all opposing players must be at least 6 metres from the ball.

There are no penalty kicks, and any free kicks for either side given within the penalty area, (10metres from the goal) shall be taken from a point on the edge of the penalty area closest to where the infringement took place.

Goal kicks may be taken from anywhere within the penalty area or from the line marking the penalty area.

4. Throw Ins

Throw-ins are to be taken. However, a foul throw will not mean an automatic turnover.

Rather, the same thrower is to be shown the correct way and allowed to throw again.

Re-throws shall be limited to one per team on each occasion the ball goes out, after which the opposing team will be awarded the throw-in.

Opposition players are not to impede the thrower or throw.

5. Substitutions

Teams should have a maximum of 6 players, only 4 to be on the field at any one time. There is no limit on the number of substitutions – unlimited interchange of players is allowed without the permission of the referee providing that:

- i) the player leaves the field completely before the substitute goes on
- ii) that there is no interruption to the flow of the game
- iii) players always enter and leave from the half-way line.

6. Balls

5th-6th Grades Size 3

7. Shin guards

Shin guards must be worn at all times, and must not be exposed.

8. Corner kicks

If on a marked small pitch – the corner shall be taken halfway from the corner flag.

9. Referees

5th - 6th_Grade - No referees are required. However, both team coaches should ensure that there is no dangerous play, and help to keep the game flowing.

10. Goals

The approved goals, will be the normal small whites goals

11. Offside

There is no “off-side” rule. However, coaches must discourage players from consistently standing in an off-side position — this is not in the spirit of the game. There is no off-side play, however players must be in their own half at kick-off.

12. Field Sizes

5th - 6th Grades - 1/4 of a standard pitch or 1/2 of a standard junior pitch.

13. Competitions

5th - 6th Grades - No points shall be awarded for games but results are recorded.

You will see that the main focus of the 5th & 6th grades is the acquisition of technique and skill.

As the player leaves the non-competitive grades they should have learned a good spread of basic technique to successfully move into the next stage of development.

Fun and enjoyment and learning new skills should be the main reason they are playing a sport.
